RECRUITER INSIGHTS: UNHCR

Skender Nushi, chief of talent development at the United Nations High Commissioner for Refugees, on what can help applications stand out.

Evolving socioeconomic contexts and a growing need for interdisciplinary action have led UNHCR to recruit a broader range of positions beyond the human rights and humanitarian aid sectors. "With emergencies, we tend to see a rise in protection roles — but the diversity spans to lots of managing roles, administration, finance, and HR," said Nushi.

Multilingualism holds high importance for UNHCR, with working knowledge of a second U.N. language — Arabic, Chinese, French, Russian, and Spanish — at the B2 level — the necessary fluency in order to communicate easily to a native speaker of the language — often being essential.

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"Applications that make it [are those that] have connected the dots. They have looked at the requirements of the position and have been able to articulate and create a storyline."

RECRUITER INSIGHTS: DRC

losif Sofios, recruitment specialist with the Danish Refugee Council's human resources team, on what skills are in demand and how applicants can stand out.

Many of the organization's jobs are based in or around crisis or conflict areas, meaning on-the-ground experience and language skills are valuable. However, there are also opportunities for candidates with no prior experience in the humanitarian and development sectors and who can support projects from a distance.

"There is [currently] demand for cross-cultural communication, and collaboration skills gained through international working experience or speaking other languages, especially the languages our people of concern speak," Sofios said.

RECRUITER INSIGHTS: IFRC

Dunja Kovac, manager of human resources in emergencies for the International Federation of Red Cross and Red Crescent Societies, on what IFRC's recruitment priorities are.

IFRC is increasingly moving toward the method of pooled recruitment. This involves a large-scale recruitment campaign to fill multiple vacancies with the same title to meet IFRC's long-term needs. "We've realized we're really struggling when it comes to support services," said Kovac, who added that it plans to remedy this by "upskilling and upscaling pools" emphasizing support services roles in finance, IT, HR, and logistics.

In terms of what makes applications stand out, "it's short applications; it's not 10- or 15-page CVs. It's really the highlights and it's applications that are tailored to the role and to us," she said.

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"We're moving very much into digital transformation so that is a skill that you'll probably see across a lot of different roles that we advertise."

Chemonics' senior specialist of talent management, Nicholle Colón Vargas, on what it looks for in top job candidates.

Chemonics collaborates on various projects — from reimagining global supply chains that deliver essential medicines to mobilizing finance in response to climate change and working with governments to address root migration causes in Central America.

"Prior experience with our clients, competitors, and partners will make an application stand out. For example, if one of our recruiters sees a CV that includes an internship with USAID or prior work experience with one of our subcontractors or competitors, that shows us that you know this business and have a genuine interest," Colón Vargas said.

Tetra Tech is on the lookout for candidates who not only possess expertise in their respective domains but also have the adaptability to tackle the multidisciplinary challenges presented by their varied clients.

"Development solutions that create positive impact are rarely straightforward — they require a deep understanding of local context and culture alongside analysis of data and evidence," said McGovern, who also emphasized the need for candidates well-versed in the domains of environmental sustainability and disaster risk finance, the ability to adapt and innovate in the face of evolving challenges.
